Through our work, we strive to empower volunteers to lead the fight for global health equity and help deliver the promise of a healthy future – one patient at a time.

TIMMY'S GOALS FOR ESSENTIAL ADVANCEMENT

Timmy Global Health believes all people, regardless of who they are, what resources they have, and where they live, should have access to quality healthcare. Timmy strives to make this vision a reality by strengthening the capacity of local health systems through short-term medical service programs and long-term health solutions.

By utilizing volunteer medical professionals, active student chapters, and community partners, we actively work together to accomplish our goals.

What initially started as a humble, grassroots effort now directly supports 10 community based projects sites in the Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Guatemala and Nigeria.

HOW TIMMY GLOBAL HEALTH WORKS



Step One:

Identify local communities in need of primary healthcare. We strengthen the capacity of local partners through short-term medical brigades and long-term public health solutions.



Step Two:

Engage and partner with medical professionals, students, and community volunteers.

Our talented medical professionals work alongside local health care providers. High school and college student chapters across the country fundraise, serve, and advocate.



Step Three:

Track patient data and improve primary healthcare through our own Electronic Medical Record system, and referral systems.

Our healthcare providers have improved data collection, tracked patient conditions, and analyzed patient data more efficiently and effectively to make programmatic and clinical decisions using TimmyCare.



Step Four:

Build capacity through our "Continuity of Care" model. Every 3 months we send volunteer medical teams to our partner communities to provide vital, primary healthcare. Our in-country staff and partners manage referrals so that all of our patients' healthcare needs are addressed--even after our medical teams have departed.



TIMMY GLOBAL HEALTH IN ACTION

Rosa is a mother of two beautiful children living in Quito, Ecuador. Recently, she started feeling some discomfort and visited a Timmy clinic through our local partner, Tierra Nueva, for answers.

Rosa was diagnosed with urinary sepsis. It began with an infection that would have been quickly and easily treated in the United States. Without treatment, however, it led to complications. The sepsis was eating away at her body, and slowly deteriorating her health. To complicate things even more, Rose was unable to pay for any of the medical treatment she needed.

Timmy invests in relationships with local organizations to make healthcare accessible for our patients. In Quito, we still have a great relationship with Tierra Nueva, our first international partner.

We partner with local medical professionals to assist in our referral program. If we can't treat patients, we make sure they get the care they need. Timmy Global Health strives to be with our patients through each step of treatment in our clinics.

We referred Rosa to a local hospital where she was cared for by a local nurse. She received the treatment at no cost to her, and has successfully recoved from her illness.

Timmy Global Health recognizes that it takes a team to care for a patient. Rosa returned to her family with her health restored thanks to the combined effort of the local MPC, Tierra Nueva medical professionals and local hospital staff.







TIMMY'S COMMITMENT TO GLOBAL HEALTHCARE

This year, 18,093 adults and children were treated in Timmy clinics, the highest number of patients treated since we began in 1997!

Our commitment to in-country partners and individual communities improves health outcomes in a systematic and profound way. Timmy's medical teams provide primary care services to partner communities every two to three months.

A DEEPER LOOK AT TWO TIMMY COMMUNITIES

Guangaje, Ecuador: An update from our newest site

Timmy is working with the onsite staff at the Centro de Salud de Guangaje; comprised of permanent and rotating staff, including an assistant nurse, gynecologist, dentist, physician, and four medical technicians. Due to understaffing in the local public hospitals, Timmy staff is working to create a network of private specialists in nearby cities to carry out referrals.

Rivers State, Nigeria: Investing in prevention

A key part of Timmy Global Health's history is the work it supports in three communities in Nigeria. We partner with the Bebor Model Nursery & Primary School in Rivers State to provide immunizations and deworming to the children. Vision services and chronic care programs are offered at Mercy Missions, our partner in the Uromi and Amichi communities.

Timmy student chapters combat health disparities at home and abroad by serving on our medical teams, raising support for our partner organizations, and advocating for health equity.

On international trips, our student volunteers shadow and scribe for doctors, work in triage and assist in the pharmacy.

We connect patients with local physicians in-country, so all patients are receiving the care they deserve.



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
