heavily in public health, education, and prevention work, moving upstream to address the root



Timmy believes that working side by side our long term partners and communities' members has a profound impact on health outcomes and the development of global health leaders. We strive for communities to hold and utilize the knowledge, tools, and resources to independently prevent illness, seek care when needed, and promote their health as a positive resource.

Through our continuity-of-care model, we work within the same communities for extended periods of time, partnering staff with local organizations and ministries of health. We strive to responsibly and ethically meet the health needs of our patients and communities by activating the resources of our global community (from volunteers to donors to partners) to provide mobile clinics, advocacy, and community-led health education focused on illness prevention, health promotion, and healthcare system navigation.

Our members have found that Timmy Chapters are so much more than week-long medical service trips. They entail a year-round commitment in addressing health disparities both locally and globally. Through local service opportunities, students meet the needs in their immediate surroundings. Fundraising efforts support referral care in our partner communities, which is a critical component of our continuity-of-care model. Plus, global health advocacy allows students to raise their voices on underlying issues impacting their communities and those of their partners.

At Timmy, we are continuing to standardize the chapter model to ensure program fidelity while inviting members to think deeper on what it means to address healthcare disparities with the resources they have access to. The total number of college chapters is growing throughout the country, and we are excited to add more students to the Timmy family of global health leaders.
